<b>MEPEU-2378</b>	General - An advanced configuration option has been added to allow a company to define a specific SQL database for temporary tables to be created in rather than utilising the default SQL TempDB
<b>MEPEU-2236</b>	Settings - To <b>optimise</b> the load <b>speed</b> when opening an existing estimate for the first time or if it was saved with 'All Items' selected in the Job Structure a new setting has been added to default the job structure selection to the <b>first level</b> . <i>Settings / Enquiry Options / Select First Level when opening an estimate</i>

## New feature details

### MEPEU-2378 – Allow users to specify a database to use for temporary data

An advanced configuration option has been added to allow a specific database to be used for temporary data where a specific IT policy precludes access to the default SQL 'tempdb'.

1. A new database should be created within the same SQL instance as the main database with the appropriate permissions
2. The 'AmtechServer.config' file needs to be located and a new line added:
  - TempDatabaseName="Database Name created in step 1"

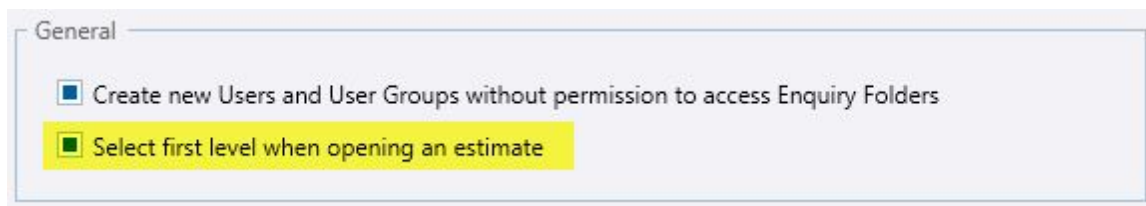
NOTE: The IIS service will need to be restarted for the change to take affect.

## New feature details

### MEPEU-2236 – Default to first level when opening an Estimate

When opening an estimate, the last level you had selected within the Job Structure of that estimate is automatically selected. This may cause a delay in opening the estimate if you had the 'All Items' option selected when you last saved and closed the estimate as every item then has to be loaded into the view.

A new setting has been created which will force the first level under 'All Items' to be selected when opening an estimate if it was saved and closed on 'All Items'. This option may be set by navigating from the Home screen to **File / Settings / Enquiry Options**.
